



### Palestinian Producer Price Index, Increase in the PPI during September 2013

The overall Producer Price<sup>1</sup> Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2011=100) reached 105.03 in September 2013, as it increased by 1.60% compared to August 2013.

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2011=100) reached 105.14 in September 2013, which indicates an increase by 1.77% compared to August 2013.

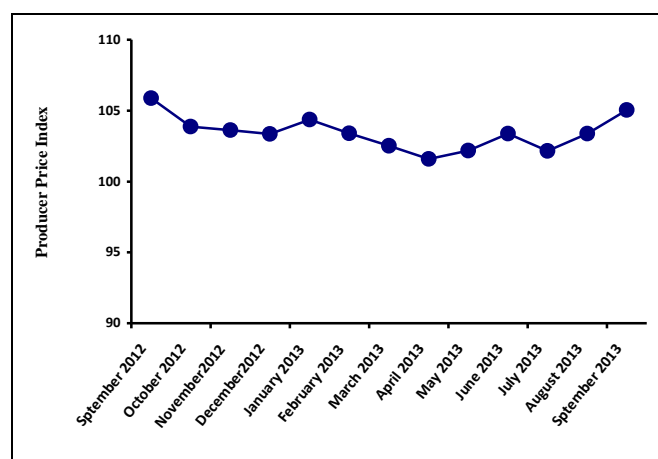
Producer Price Index for exported products (2011=100) reached 103.94 in September 2013, which indicates a decrease by 0.06% compared to August 2013.

The changes of Producer Price Index for September 2013 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Groups	%Change
Agriculture goods:	+ 4.41%
Manufacturing group:	+ 0.05%
Mining and quarrying:	0.00%
Fishing:	- 4.47%

<sup>1</sup> The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
