



**Palestinian Producer Price Index,
November, 11/2013**

Decrease in the PPI during November 2013

The overall Producer Price¹ Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2011=100) reached 102.22 in November 2013, as it decreased by 2.14% compared to October 2013.

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2011=100) reached 102.08 in November 2013, which indicates a decrease by 2.32% compared to October 2013.

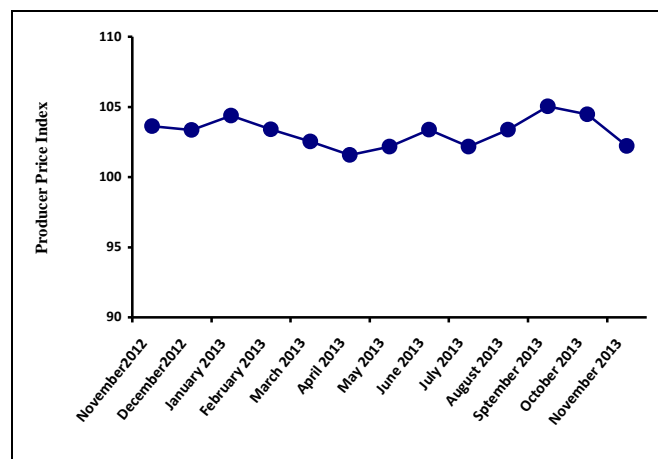
Producer Price Index for exported products (2011=100) reached 103.67 in November 2013, which indicates a decrease by 0.28% compared to October 2013.

The changes of Producer Price Index for November 2013 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Groups	% Change
Agriculture goods:	- 5.98%
Fishing:	- 0.79%
Mining and quarrying:	- 0.38%
Manufacturing group:	+ 0.10%

¹ The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
