An increase in Trade Balance Deficit for Registered* Goods by 14% in September, 09/2025 compared to September 2024.

Exports in Goods

Exports increased in September, 2025 by 48% compared to September, 2024 and reached USD 184.1 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in September, 2025 by 47% compared to September, 2024 and it represented 90% of total exports in September, 2025.


At the same time, exports to other countries increased by 55% during the same period compared to September, 2024.

Imports in Goods

Imports increased in September, 2025 by 21% compared to September, 2024 and reached USD 675.2 Million.

Imports from Israel increased by 28% in September, 2025 compared to September, 2024 and it represented 64% of total imports in September, 2025.

At the same time, imports from other countries increased by 12% compared to September, 2024.



Trade Balance on Registered Goods

The trade balance, which represents the difference between exports and imports, showed an increase in trade deficit by 14% in September, 2025 compared to September, 2024 and reached USD 491.1 Million.
