# Press Release on Hotel Activities Survey in West Bank during the Third Quarter 2014

### **About 100 Thousand Guests Spent 273 Thousand Nights**

During the third quarter of 2014, 99,811 guests stayed in hotels in the West Bank: 28% were from European Union countries and 11% were Palestinian.

The number of hotel guests was 52% lower than in the previous quarter and 27% lower than in the third quarter of 2013.

During the third quarter of 2014, the number of guest nights in West Bank hotels was 272,567 thousand: of these guests, 11% were Palestinian, 31% were from European Union countries and 13% were from the United States and Canada.

During the third quarter of 2014, there were 2,927 hotel workers: 2,252 males and 675 females.

### **Hotel Room Occupancy**

The room occupancy rate in West Bank was 23% in the third quarter of 2014.

Room occupancy during the third quarter of 2014 was 26% lower than in the previous quarter and 1% lower than in the third quarter of 2013.

### **Hotel Capacity by Region**

In September 2014, show that 109 hotels out of 118 hotels operating in the West Bank responded to the third quarter 2014 survey and have available 6,577 rooms with a total of 14,576 beds. These were distributed by region as follows:

- North of West Bank: 15 hotels comprising 289 rooms with 843 beds.
- Middle of West Bank: 36 hotels comprising 1,598 rooms with 3,452 beds
- Jerusalem: 22 hotels comprising 1,472 rooms with 3,270 beds.
- South of West Bank: 36 hotels comprising 3,218 rooms with 7,011 beds.
